Training Requirements

This course is designed for anyone:

- With experience of teaching English.
- Interested in teaching English and in maintaining good practice for continuing professional development (CPD).
- Already working in applied linguistics or related fields, who wants an update on current thinking and practice for the classroom.

Assessment

No formal assessment is required. The self-study provides opportunities for reflection and updating knowledge.

In the live online workshops participants will be expected to contribute to activities during the workshops through discussion and interaction with peers in breakout rooms, submitting chat box comments, online voting and being invited to share experiences and views with everyone present in the session. Interactive and participative methods will be built into the workshops.

Training Topics

The training topics in the British TESOL Professional Certificate cover the 14 areas presented independently in the self-study and module and are divided into 5 workshops for the online live sessions. Each workshop is two hours in duration delivered online or face-to-face.

The training considers practical teaching tips and allows participants to share their experiences with expert trainers & colleagues.

Workshop 2

Online learning Skills – Teaching Reading, Writing, Listening & Speaking.

Workshop 3

Embedding methodology approaches, Academic English, Materials Investigation and Teaching Large Classes.

Workshop 4

New innovative methodologies Language Awareness.

Workshop 5

A focus on the 4 C's – Communication, Critical Thinking, Creativity, Collaboration 21st century skills, Teaching Vocabulary and World Englishes.

The Training aims to give participants the opportunity to...

- Explore and enhance the skills necessary to become a competent and capable English language teacher.
- Acquire the underpinning knowledge and skills required to teach English as a second language.
- Interact and share experiences and views with fellow professionals and reflect on their own practice.
- Validate and recognise their experience of teaching English language
- Develop new skills and knowledge that can be immediately applied to the participant's own teaching context.
- Prepare to take up positions in educational establishments or to work independently
- Demonstrate an understanding of the value of continuous professional development (CPD) and the means available for this.
- Develop skills in English language usage, teaching and assessment, teaching skills, developing and evaluating teaching materials.
- Reflect on their own performance and professional development.
